Qualifications include a Diploma or degree in a human service area, excellent communication and mediation skills, at least one year experience working with children and families, and experience working in a school environment. Knowledge of the community and local/regional available resources for children and families is required. Multilingual skills would be an asset. A valid class 5 AB driver's license, \$2 million insured vehicle, and First Aid Certification are required. Prior to final hiring, Police Record and CYIM checks, along with a driver's abstract, must be provided. Salary is based on 160 hours/month.
